Your Complete Guide to NON-QM Mortgage Approval

Getting approved for a mortgage as a self-employed borrower doesn't have to be complicated. This checklist will help you prepare everything you need for a smooth approval process.

Bank Statement Loan (12 or 24 months)

- Personal and/or business bank statements (12 or 24 months)
- Profit & Loss statement (CPA-prepared preferred)
- Business license or proof of self-employment
- Credit report (minimum 620 score)
- Down payment funds (typically 10-20%)
- Property appraisal
- Government-issued photo ID

1099 Income Loan

- 1099 forms (most recent 2 years)
- Personal tax returns (2 years)
- Year-to-date P&L; statement
- Credit report (minimum 620 score)
- Down payment funds (typically 10-20%)
- Property appraisal
- Government-issued photo ID

How We Calculate Your Income

Bank Statement Method:

We analyze your deposits over 12 or 24 months and apply an expense ratio (typically 50%) to determine your qualifying income. Business accounts get better expense ratios than personal accounts.

1099 Method:

We use your 1099 income from the past 2 years, averaging the amounts to determine your qualifying income. This works great for contractors and gig workers.

Pro Tips for Self-Employed Borrowers

- **Keep business and personal expenses separate:** Use a dedicated business account for better expense ratios
- **Maintain consistent deposits:** Lenders like to see steady income patterns
- **Don't make large unusual deposits:** These can complicate underwriting
- **Have 6-12 months reserves:** Shows financial stability
- **Work on your credit score:** Higher scores = better rates and terms
